Date of birth:	 swelling of lips, face, eyes hives or welts tingling mouth abdominal pain, vomiting (these are signs of a severe allergic reaction to <u>insects</u>)

	 For insect allergy, flick out sting if visible. Do not remove ticks Stay with person and call for help
Confirmed allergens:	 Give medications (if prescribed)
Family/emergency contact name(s):	Watch for <u>any one</u> of the following signs of Anaphylaxis
