Who Can Audition?

- All students from year 7 through to year 12 can audition.
- All students will have a place in the production if they attend the general auditions.
- Students in Year 7 can only audition for an ensemble role.

What to Expect?

General Audition

- All students who want to take part in the 2024 musical production MUST attend the general audition.
- Students will be required to dance and sing at this audition.
- You do not need any prior dance experience to audition.
- Students will be taught a short routine which you will be asked to perform in groups.
- Be sure to wear clothes you can move in (sweatpants, shorts, leggings, etc.) and bring a water bottle!

Lead Audition

- All students interested in auditioning for a lead role must also attend the general audition.
- All students interested in auditioning for a lead role must sign up to a time slot using the the online sign-up sheet: <u>https://forms.gle/8ygUkU34idA67bZk8</u>
- Students will be asked to present the monologue and song for their audition that aligns with their desired character. See below for more information regarding this.

Call-Back Audition

- Call-back auditions are for the production team to see you one more time before casting.
- Not all students who audition for a lead role will receive a call back audition.
- The focus for the call-back audition will be looking at how well you collaborate with other actors and may provide an opportunity to present an alternate character to your original audition.

Things to Note

- There will be no cost to join the production.
- Students will however, be required to attend the production camp. The cost for the production camp will be approximately \$200-\$250 (CSEF will be available for eligible students as well as payment options).
- Production T-shirts will be optional and will be charged to the student at approximately \$30-\$40.
- Rehearsals are on Thursday nights from 3:30pm-7:00pm. You MUST be able to attend these.
- There will also be compulsory rehearsals on the Term 1 & 2 holidays that the cast will be required to attend.
- If you accept a role, you are entering into a long-term, collaborative commitment.

ALICE SPENCER

Full of questions, wonder, and a tenacious stubbornness when it comes to achieving her goals. Entering a confusing time of transition in her body while trying to survive a distressed situation - living in a tube station, displaced from her family. She possesses a wonderful imagination that allows her to escape her present situation.

Doubles as White Rabbit: Attractive, obsessive-compulsive, and a little manic - running from something he doesn't understand.
